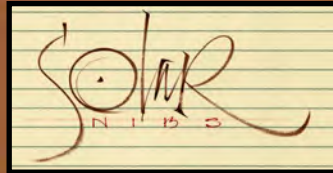

will weigh down the glued items)**

**Scrap papers to protect paper when gluing (old magazines,
catalogues, etc.)**

AMAZON SMILE

To register with Amazon Smile, go to smile.amazon.com. The first time you visit the web site, they should ask which charity you would like to support. Type Society for Calligraphy and you can select it at that time. Every item available for purchase on www.amazon.com is also available on Amazon Smile (smile.amazon.com) at the same price. You will see eligible products marked "Eligible for Amazon Smile donation" on their product detail page. GRACEFUL ENVELOPE CONTEST

The Washington Calligraphers Guild has sent out a call for entries for the 2019 Graceful Envelope Contest. The theme is **PUT YOUR STAMP ON IT** and the deadline for submissions is Monday, March 25, 2019.

This year's theme celebrates the 25th anniversary of the Graceful Envelope Contest and the 125th anniversary of the US commemorative stamps. Your challenge is to create an envelope that commemorates anything of your choosing.

Make sure your submission reflects the artistic hand lettering and imaginative use of color and design that have been the hallmarks of the contest. And, of course, incorporate postage stamps into your creation.

The 2018 Best in Show (right) was by Gerry Jackson Kerdok. The theme was **Whatever the Weather**.

CONTEST RULES:

Only one entry is allowed per person. There is no entry fee. Each entry must be a stamped envelope, either manufactured or handmade, delivered through the U.S. Postal Service. The envelope will not be opened. Entries may not be enclosed in a separate envelope or in any protective covering. Size may not exceed 7" x 9". Standard #10 business envelopes are also permitted.

You should use calligraphy or hand-drawn artistic lettering to address the front of the envelope.

On the back of the envelope, print your name, address and e-mail, clearly labeled "FROM:".
