ABOUT ANNIE

The world of books has captivated Annie Cicale since she was a child. Fascinated by writing, her first Osmiroid fountain pen led her to the world of calligraphy. After a short stint as a chemical engineer, she returned to school, receiving a BFA in printmaking and an MFA in graphic design; she now calls herself an intuitive engineer. She has taught calligraphy workshops throughout North America, Japan, Spain and Australia, and has had a number of one person exhibits, including the installation of "The Face of Humanity" at galleries in Tennessee, Montana, Illinois and North Carolina. Her artist's books are in public and private collections, including the Design Library at Yale University. She is the author of *The Art and Craft of Hand Lettering*, revised in 2018. She divides her time among teaching, graphic design work, painting and making artist's books. When not in the studio, she can be found in a swimming pool teaching water aerobics, in her garden, or hiking, with treks in Peru and Nepal testing the patience of her knee surgeon.

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

With GPS and Google Maps, you might think map making skills are no longer needed, but a hand-made map can be a treasure. In

this workshop we will talk about the many kinds of maps, both geographical and other kinds, and then learn ways to make them. We'll talk about various kinds of information included on maps, see some historical versions that might surprise you, and think about how we engage with the land. You'll choose a topic, and then learn some cartographic techniques. You can make a camera-ready version of your space, or you can make a fine painterly map to hang on a wall. Those Tolkien maps of Middle Earth can't be found on your smart phone, and you too might want to design a map of your own imaginary space.

We will review the letterforms you know, adapting them to various places on your maps, from simple place names to complicated titles. We'll learn some of the cartographic traditions to make your map accessible and reliable for your audience, whether it is just a map to your house from the airport, a map to the wedding reception or a fantastic place you made up yourself. The emphasis in this class will be on learning the design skills needed to make a map, but with a bit of fun thrown in as well.

Workshop is limited to 20 participants. Enrollment is for current paid Society for Calligraphy members only. Your membership must be current at time of sign-up as well as when class is held. No reservation will be held until your dues are current. If your membership lapses, you become ineligible and your space will be filled from the waiting list. Sign-ups are accepted in advance on a first come, first served basis. No refunds unless your place can be filled from a wait list. If you must cancel, please do so early enough for your place to be filled. For confirmation and prompt receipt of supply list, we recommend that your check arrive no later than two weeks before the workshop.
