Art and Heart:

The Passion that is The Saint John's Bible



This lecture will discuss the art and history of The Saint John's Bible, the first completely handwritten and illuminated Bible commissioned by a Benedictine Abbey since the invention of the printing press. Conceived by master calligrapher Donald Jackson, the Bible was commissioned in 1998 and completed in 2011. Divided into seven volumes, the Bible is the work of over a dozen calligraphers, artists and illuminators. A copy of the Heritage Edition of the Gospels and Acts is currently on display at Chapman University.

Rev. Nancy Brink is the Director of Church Relations at Chapman University in Orange, CA since January 2009. She first encountered The Saint John's Bible while a pastor in Omaha when an exhibition of the Bible came to the Joslyn Museum of Art in that city. She was instrumental in bringing the Gospel & Acts volume of the Heritage Edition of The Saint John's Bible to the campus for a year in 2019. She has organized a team of Church Relations staff, faculty, library staff and community members to create a year of events to engage visitors to explore this volume.
