- Calligraphy Practice Paper with lines for Italic. (i.e. Bienfang)
- 8-10 sheets of 8.5" x 11" Opaque smooth, good quality calligraphy paper (i.e. Strathmore, Borden & Riley)
- 3 graphite pencils (i.e. Cretacolor Monolith Woodless Graphite Pencils, 4B, 6B, 8B)
- 1 Art Graf Graphite Stick - Soft if available
- Blender Stumps or Sticks or Q-tips
- Paper Towels
- Rubber Gloves, if possible. (They will also be provided in class)
- Wear black (or an apron!)
